- 2. Applicant must be in good academic standing planning to attend a college, vocational or technical school.
- 3. Scholarships will not be awarded to foreign exchange students, home schooled students or out of district students.
- 4. Answer each question thoroughly, check for content. Each question is scored.
- 5. Typed applications are preferred, however, applications neatly written in ink are acceptable.
- 6. Attach your current OHS transcript. It is *required*.
- 7. Include two letters of recommendation for extra bonus points.
- 8. Attach signed checklist.
- 9. Include a NICE 3"x 5" graduation photo of yourself on photo paper.
- 10. This application <u>MUST</u> be signed by the applicant.
- 11. A parent or guardian <u>MUST</u> also sign this application if you are under age 18.
- 12. Incomplete or illegible applications will be discarded.
- 13. Late, emailed or hand delivered applications will not be accepted.
